

## Biosketch Daniel Desgrandchamps

Daniel Desgrandchamps is a physician specialized in pediatrics and infectious diseases. He was trained in internal medicine, pediatrics, medical microbiology and public health. From 1996 to 2006, he was running his own pediatric office and took care of infectious diseases at the Children's Hospital in Luzern and the Swiss Red Cross (Refugee program). He has been a member of the Swiss and the Federal Vaccination Commission for many years. From 2006 to 2011 and again from 2013 to 2016, he worked in different leadership roles in international pharmaceutical companies, mainly in vaccinology. From 2011 to 2013, he worked in the field of hospital administration for several Swiss pediatric university clinics.

Since October 2016, Dr Desgrandchamps acts as the Swiss Vaccination Technical Committee's (EKIF, CFV) scientific secretary, and as a scientific collaborator for the foundation [meineimpfungen.ch](http://meineimpfungen.ch) / [mesvaccins.ch](http://mesvaccins.ch). In 2018, he returned part-time as a clinical pediatrician to a private office.
